



### A shipwrecked Viola, believing her twin brother Sebastian has drowned, washes up on the shore of Illyria. She disguises herself

**as a man,** 'Cesario,' and is employed by Orsino, with whom she falls in love. Orsino asks 'Cesario' to help him woo Olivia, who has long rejected Orsino's advances, and who quickly falls for 'Cesario.'

Olivia's uncle Sir Toby is staying with her, along with his foolish friend Sir Andrew. While partying loudly one night with the 'fool' Feste,

a musician, they anger Olivia's severe steward, Malvolio, and then devise, along with Maria and Fabian, a plot to trick Malvolio by forging a cryptic letter that convinces him that Olivia loves him. Olivia, confronted by an emboldened Malvolio, thinks him mad, and he is confined in a dark room by the conspirators.

Meanwhile, with the help of his friend Antonio, Sebastian, who has survived the shipwreck, finds his way

To Illyria, and is challenged to a duel by Sir Toby, who mistakes him for the less formidable 'Cesario.' Olivia then mistakes the more willing Sebastian for his disguised twin sister, and leads him off to a priest to marry. Confusion and complications ensue, only to be resolved in the end with Orsino married to Viola, Olivia to Sebastian, and the separated twins joyfully reunited. Malvolio, released from confinement and discovering how he has been tricked, swears he'll be revenged, and Feste brings the comedy to a close with a song.

Saheem Ali, whose luminescent MERRY WIVES reopened The Delacorte after the pandemic shut us down, is once again taking the helm of our reopening effort, this time with one of the greatest comedies ever written.

What happens on The Delacorte stage feels different because it is different: yes, it is some of our greatest actors and artists in work by the world's greatest playwright, set in the sylvan glade of Central Park in the midst of the greatest city in the world—but what really makes it magical is the relationship between the stage and you, the audience. THE PUBLIC continues the work of its visionary founder Joe Papp as a civic institution engaging, both on stage and off, with some of the most important ideas and social issues of today. Conceived over 60 years ago as one of the nation's first nonprofit theatres, The Public has long operated on the principles that theatre is an essential cultural force and that art and culture belong to everyone. Under the leadership of Artistic Director Oskar Eustis and Executive Director Patrick Willingham, The Public's wide breadth of programming includes an annual season of new work at its landmark home at Astor Place, Free Shakespeare in the Park at The Delacorte Theater in Central Park, the Mobile Unit touring throughout New York City's five boroughs, Public Lab, Public Works, Public Shakespeare Initiative and Joe's Pub. Since premiering Hair in 1967. The Public continues to create the canon of American theatre and is currently represented on Broadway by the Tony Award-winning musicals *Hamilton* by Lin-Manuel Miranda and Hell's Kitchen by Alicia Keys and Kristoffer Diaz. Their programs and productions can also be seen regionally across the country and around the world. 
